Subject: Clarification on the announcement made on 6/9/2020 about vehicle with tinted or shaded window glasses

Reference to your letter without number dated 7th Sept. 2020, regarding petition on traffic police announcement on factory shaded window glasses of vehicles; the administration of traffic police would like to clarify this point as hereunder:-

- 1. In fact the top leadership of the police bans the use of vehicle with shaded windows either from the factory or not for security reason. The owners were advice to change the glasses of their vehicles.
- 2. But, because it is not easy to find the glasses here especially the vehicles coming from the factory with the shaded window glasses; the administration of traffic police use to register and give the sticker for identification for the period of six (6) months as directed by top leadership of police.
- 3. That period given is to enable the owner to look for the alternative to change the shaded glasses. But some are still come to look for additional six months claiming that he/she could not yet find the transparent glasses.



- 4. For the case of those who tint glasses of their vehicles without reason and without permission; their vehicles will be detain and the case should be open against them for the violation of the directives.
- 5. Also any person using vehicle with shaded or tinted glass from factory without being register and given permission shall be held accountable for his/her violation.

Subject: Ministerial Order for the Prohibition of Tinted Vehicles

Reference to the Ministerial order No. 31 date July 14th 2017 directed the Directorate of Traffic for the implementation of the above mentioned.

It appeared that most of the Sectors CDRs are charging the owners of tinted vehicles on the road with harassment.

Pursuant to the powers conferred upon me under Article 114/2 of South Sudan Transitional Constitution 2011 amended 2015 and regulation in South Sudan Act 2016; I Lt. Gen. Michael Chiangjiek Geay, Minister of Interior, do hereby issue Ministerial Order No. 57/2018 for the Sectors to Implement the following;

1. All Sectors CDRs must stop charging or putting fine on any Tinted Cars at their respective HQs. It should be done at the Traffic Police HQs.

2. Any Sectors CDRs found practicing or harassing vehicles on the road shall face police administrative measure

3. Any Sectors CDRs should avoid inlawful activities on the roads.

The Inspector General of Police (CP) shall take necessary action for implementation of this order immediately.

- The traffic code number for government vehicles considered is Goss. All RSS number plate must be removed.
- 7. All states police who violate this must face the law.
