



ADVERTISEMENT Journalism Training For Academic Year 2023/2024

Juba; August 7, 2023 - Media Development Institute (MDI), the training wing of Association for Media Development In South Sudan (AMDISS), is enrolling new trainees for its one-year training program in journalism. It is a certificate program starting in Mid-September for the academic year 2023/24 intake.

Aspiring candidates who are interested to build career in journalism can apply directly, while practicing journalists are to apply through respective media houses. This training is based in Juba and it is non-residential. The training methodology uses both classroom lectures and practical field work, including internship program. The classes run from Monday to Friday from 8:00am-12:00pm. Admissions are awarded based on a competitive process including attending interviews once the candidates are selected. The management reserves the right not to admit a candidate who will not meet the criteria administered during the interviews and assessment test.

Academic requirements for enrolment:

In order to enroll, the applicant must fulfill the following requirements:

- i. Must be a South Sudanese National
- ii. Must have a Diploma or Degree from a recognized College or University
- iii. Practicing Journalists without formal journalism training are highly encouraged to apply to professionalize their skills
- iv. Must possess a strong command of English Language which is the medium of training and instruction
- v. Must have commitment to undertake this course without interruptions for the entire one year period of training
- vi. Must not be an ongoing student of any university or any learning institution or a committed staff of any institution. Practicing journalists who are recommended by their respective media houses are required to be released from their work for the period of the one year
- vii. Interested applicants can pick MDI Entry Form with a non-refundable fee of SSP 5,000 from MDI/AMDISS Secretariat, located along Kokora Road, 150m from UNDP Office, Juba South Sudan.
- viii. Once admitted, you shall be required to contribute at least 15% to the tuition, while some part shall be contributed by our partners.

Interested applicants who have met the above requirements should submit a hand written cover letter; a completed MDI Entry Form; photocopy of National ID (Nationality) and photocopies of academic certificates. Practicing journalists are to submit samples of their work and recommendation letter from their media houses as an additional requirement.
