SUBJECT: ENFORCEMENT OF THE NEW CUSTOMS MERCHANDISE CONVERSION VALUE INTRODUCED BY THE FINANCIAL ACT, 2023/24 WITH EFFECT FROM 1ST NOVEMBER 2023

1. CLARIFICATION

This circular on the new Customs Merchandise Conversion Value is hereby issued to inform and guide the general taxpaying community, especially all importers and exporters, clearing agents and freight forwarders, tax practitioners, business entities, Government institutions, Non-Governmental Organizations and Inter-Governmental/International Organizations that following the enactment of the Financial Act 2023/24 by the Reconstituted Transitional National Legislative Assembly (RTNLA) and the subsequent assent by His Excellency the President of the Republic of South Sudan Gen. Salva Kiir Mayardit, the Customs Merchandise Conversion Value shall, with effect from 1st November, 2023, be 300 SSP to 1 USD.

2. MANDATE OF THE NRA:


