Subject: Amendment of the Circular on Radio Talk shows and Public Announcements:

Based on the meeting conducted and chaired by the Minister of Information and Communication Hon. Elizabeth Nyadak John between *the Ministry of Information and Communication, Union of Journalists of South Sudan (UJOSS-Jonglei branch)* and civil activists organizations represented by *INTREPID South Sudan (ISS)* today on 11 January 2024, where the three institutions held a thorough meeting on the latest directives made by the ministry on public announcements and radio talk shows.

The following amendment resolutions were agreed upon as follows:

1. Inclusion of three local languages (Dinka, Nuer and Anuak) in public announcement.
2. Ministry of Information and Communication to revert Radio Talk shows and Announcement approval.
3. UJOSS to monitor the performance of the Journalists in the State.
4. Civil Activists to remain neutral in their activism on State affairs.
5. Radio Station Managers to verify information before going on air.
6. Media houses and freelances to provide visibility materials (Branded Jackets, Caps, ID Cards) to their staffs especially during official duties.

Note: This is to ensure that the circular complies with article 24 and 32 of the transitional constitution of South Sudan and article 19 of the universal declaration on human right.
