PUBLIC CIRCULAR

TO: ALL ELECTRONIC DEALERS/IMPORTERS

Dear CEOs/MDs,

RE: CIRCULAR ON REGISTRATION OF ELECTRONIC DEALERS/IMPORTERS

We refer to the above matter.

The National Communication Authority (NCA) is the statutory body mandated by National Communication Act, 2012, as the government agency mandated to license and regulate the Telecommunications and ICT sector in the country which includes among others: managing frequency, telecommunications, Import, Assembly, Manufacture and trading in communication equipment and materials.

Pursuant to Sections 30 and 70 of the National Communication Act, 2012, the Authority hereby issues this directive to all Companies or individuals engaging in unlicensed importation, assembly, manufacturing, installation, trade in communication equipment and materials or dealing in marketing communication equipment, materials and systems without specifications and Type Approval recognized by the Authority are hereby instructed to register such businesses or services with the National Communication Authority (NCA) for compliance and licensing within 30 working days.

Failure by the Companies or individuals to comply to this circular after lapse of 30 working days, the Authority will have no alternative but to invoke its powers under the provisions of Sections 97 and 98 of the National Communication Act, 2012, read together with section 25 of the National Communications Licensing Regulations, 2016, which impose penalties including but not limited to prosecution, fines, closure of businesses and or confiscation of items.
