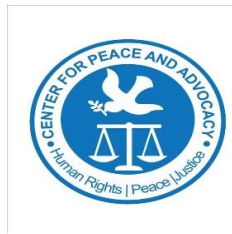


An incident occurred in the Morobi settlements in Uganda

Morobi Refugee Settlement, located in Palorinya Parish of Moyo District, Northern Uganda, is a refugee settlement. The Center for Peace and Advocacy (CPA) has urged the government of Uganda to capture the man responsible for these acts and bring him to justice.

According to reliable sources obtained by CPA, the man is still hiding in the bushes with the intention of causing harm to more people in the Morobi Refugee Settlement.

The incident occurred at 10 AM in one of the settlements in Uganda. A man named Mr. Chol Agok from Warrap State forcefully took a gun from a Ugandan policewoman on Saturday. When the Ugandan authorities attempted to pursue him, he fired gunshots and people stopped following him.

A witness, whose name is being withheld for security reasons, stated that the man killed a young boy from Fangak County at 1 AM on Sunday. When they were taking the boy to the hospital, he passed away on the way.

Chol Agok has warned the members of the settlement that the Dinka tribe should leave and that his problem lies with members of the Nuer community according to the source of information CPA has got from the witness in the Morobi.
